MALAY LIFESTYLES

Kuantan the capital of Pahang is the largest state in Peninsula Malaysia; it offers the visitors to experience a slow motion life style that is rich in traditional & cultural activities. Your first stop will be at Cherating Village. Here life is "slow motion" where seaside folk will be engaged with their local handicrafts, as such at the Pandanus Weaving center you will have the opportunity to admire the local grasses, which have been artfully woven into hats, handbags and tablemats. Then you will proceed to a local Malay village to observe and maybe participate in some of the cultural activities which includes, Top Spinning, Flying the Malaysian Kite and watching the trained Monkey plucking coconuts from a tall coconut palm. After this visit, you will visit a Batik Cottage Industry to view the traditional process of printing exquisite pieces of contemporary designs using dyes, wax and traditional touch. Following this interesting visit you will be taken on a scenic drive of the residential suburbs, where you have the opportunity to see the Regent and the Chief Minister's residences. The final stop you will spend time at one of the most popular beachfronts in Kuantan, Teluk Chempedak where you can either walk along the beach or shop for some souvenirs or, take a stroll on the wooden walkway at Teluk Pelindung nearby which you may be able to watch the waves breaking onto the rocks of the promontory.

SUNGAI LEMBING'S GLORIOUS PAST

On this tour you will travel to Sungai Lembing. During its heyday, Sungai Lembing had the largest, longest and deepest subterranean tin mine in the world and was once the richest town and producer of tin in Pahang. It was considered as the El-Dorado of the East in the then Malaya, as it contained a large community of British at Lembah Sungai Kenau (Kenau River Valley). Tin has been mined in Pahang since the prehistoric times. But as tin lost its luster and other minerals and synthetic materials replaced its uses, the mines here slowly ceased to operate and became just memories of old. As such you will visit the Sungai Lembing Museum that was established to show the present and future generations the vibrant and colorful days of Sungai Lembing's past, its vital importance in the economy of the state and country, and as a dedication to the workers and personalities who once contributed to its glory days. The Sungai Lembing Museum, formerly the residence of a British official and here you can find various exhibits and artifacts from the town's glorious tin-rich days, including mining equipment, mineworkers' costumes, furniture and tableware. There are even administrative mining tools and equipments of the mine displayed in the museum – from the mining attires and basic tools used during mining, such as hard hats, carbide lamps and battery-operated lamps, to the equipments used during that era, such as calculators, telegrams and typewriters, down to the utensils and furniture they used back in the days. After the visit at the museum, you will travel and stop at one of the most popular beachfronts in Kuantan, Teluk Chempedak you can either walk along the beach or shop for some souvenirs. Or, take a stroll on the wooden walkway at Teluk Pelindung nearby, and you may be able to watch the waves breaking on the rocks of the promontory.

AYUDDHAYA ANCIENT CAPITAL

In order to discover any country, you must learn about its history. In Thailand, the ruined city of Ayutthaya is a must for any visitor. The magnificent ruins afford a glimpse of the original island city of moats, palaces, and grand temples with rows of enigmatic stone


Buddhas. Once known as the "Oriental Venice", its pagodas and palaces were much admired by ancient travellers. You will then visit the equally beautiful and important 400-year-old Bang Pa-In Summer Palace with its eclectic blend of Thai, European and Chinese influences. The palace consists of five imposing buildings: a delightful Thai-style pavilion standing in the middle of an artificial lake, a two-storey pavilion built in European style that serves as a hall for state ceremonies, a pavilion formerly used as a residence during the high-water season, a Chinese-style pavilion where the court generally resided during the rainy and cool season, and an observatory on a small island commanding wonderful views over the surrounding countryside. You will have the chance to enjoy an elephant ride (2 people per elephant) before visiting Wat Phra Sri Sanphet, the most important temple in the old ruined Royal Grand Palace compound, which once had the same functions as the Emerald Buddha Temple in Bangkok. Next you will visit Wat Phra Mongkhon Bophit, which contains one of the world's largest seated Buddhas. Many smaller Buddha figures were also discovered here. The vihara (hall) was destroyed when the Burmese sacked Ayutthaya in 1767 and was rebuilt in its original style in 1956. You will also visit the Wat Yai Chai Mongkol, a temple built by King U Thong in 1357 for meditation. This massive ruined pagoda can be seen from a great distance. Following a Thai buffet lunch at a local restaurant you will travel back to the port

LANDMARKS OF BANGKOK

No visit to Bangkok is complete without a tour of the city's main sights. Back on dry land you will enjoy an international buffet lunch at a local restaurant before having the chance to shop for souvenirs, Thai silk, semiprecious stones, handicrafts, and other local wares before heading back to the ship.

SCENES OF BANGKOK

Bangkok is a truly enchanting city, with smiling people, golden-spired temples and beautiful palaces and monuments. This leisurely scenic tour will offer you an overview of the city, including a drive around the inner part of the old city of Bangkok, the "City of Angels". Your first stop will be the Jessadabodin Pavilion, which is the perfect spot to take some photos of the inner city. It offers fine views of the Golden Mount Temple (the highest in Bangkok), Wat Ratchanadda, the only remaining metal pagoda in the world, the ancient forts and the surviving sections of the old city walls. You will then enjoy a sightseeing tour, driving past the Constitution

Monument, Sunday Ground, City Pillar Shrine, Grand Palace, Emerald Buddha Temple, Ministry of Defence, and Reclining Buddha Temple before arriving at the Suthat Temple. Here you will be able to admire the huge bronze Sukhothai-period Buddha dating from the fifteenth century and the murals decorating the ordination hall. Nearby, opposite the temple, you will see the Giant Swing. This pair of red teak pillars was once used for the Brahmanic Swing Festival. Before being banned in 1932, teams of young Hindu priests would swing through a full 180-degree arc while trying to snatch a bag of gold coins between their teeth. While some were successful in retrieving it, many lost their lives during the attempt. Later you will enjoy an international buffet lunch at a local restaurant, followed by the chance to take some photos at the beautiful Marble Temple (Wat Benchamabophit), built from precious white Italian Carrara marble. Finally, you will have the chance to do some shopping before returning to the ship.

ANGTHONG MARINE PARK AND SNORKELING

On board a local speed boat you will reach Anghong National Marine Park, a place for an ideal trip to view some of the area's breathtaking coastal scenery. The park is formed by 42 tiny island, which consist of steep-sided outcrops of limestone rising from the sea. Steeped in natural beauty, secluded bays hide beaches of pristine white sand, ideal for swimming and relaxing. GEORGETOWN AND SUBURBS

You will travel past the main commercial district into the outskirts of Georgetown, passing the official residence of Penang's governor. On your way to the Botanical Gardens you will drive along roads lined with huge rain trees and flanked by handsome suburban houses and some of the beautiful colonial homes built during the period of British rule. You will stop at the Penang Botanical Gardens, also known as the Waterfall Gardens, for a pleasant stroll. The gardens were laid out by the British in 1884, and offer an extensive display of native and hybrid orchids, cacti, a wide variety of ferns, bamboo plants, flowering trees and shrubs. They are inhabited by long-tailed macaques, which will add some excitement to your visit. Just 100 meters from the gates of the Botanical Gardens is a batik showroom, where you will be able to witness the techniques of decorating fabric using dyes and wax. Next you will visit the bustling waterfront, where the houses on stilts form a water village built by the early Chinese immigrants, hinting at Penang's past. You will then stop at the Baba Nyonya Museum, also known as the Pinang Peranakan Mansion or the Chung Keng Kwee Museum. This was formally a private home belonging to the Chinese head of the Hai San secret society. The building - an impressive Straits Eclectic-style mansion - is an architectural marvel. The late-Victorian influence is particularly clear in the profuse use of decorative cast iron, and this is one of the few buildings in Penang whose cast iron fixtures survived the Japanese occupation intact. You will marvel at the painstaking restoration of this house and its breathtaking antique furniture and woodwork. A Baba guide well versed in Baba Nyonya culture and Chinese Feng Shui will explain in detail what each carving, design, and painting depicts. This mansion is a storehouse of antiques. A life-size statue of Chung Keng Kwee himself, attired in his Mandarin's robe and a Manchu Mandarin cap, is displayed in his family temple next to the house.

It also showcases a wide variety of other interesting creatures, such as water dragons and giant scorpions, along with many other inhabitants of the forest. The landscaped gardens feature waterfalls, ponds, wooden bridges and a rock tunnel. Scents of clove and nutmeg will follow as you drive through the hills, where you will stop at a local fruit and spice stall for a closer look at the fresh species and local fruits. Before going back to the ship, you will have the chance to see the other side of Penang, the quiet Malay villages, known as Kampung. This are scattered all over the island, giving you a true taste of the local life.

HERITAGE TRAIL OF MALACCA

This is a city with a glorious past hidden behind each façade of the centuries-old buildings. The history of Malaysia is said to have begun in Malacca. It was a great seaport where the Portuguese, Dutch and British took turns to rule. Malacca is undoubtedly the wealthiest when it comes to history, culture and cuisine. Every step you take down the narrow winding streets, you will find a piece of historical treasure waiting to be discovered or an enchanting story waiting to be told. Let's take a stroll down memory lane because here is where it all began ... You will visit to the Stadthuys (outside visit only) – built as the official residence for the Dutch governors and their officers. It's an excellent example of Dutch architecture of that era. Porta de Santiago was built by the Portuguese in 1511 as a fortress and, during the Dutch invasion, it sustained severe structural damage. When the British took over Malacca, they set out to destroy it but the timely intervention by Sir Stamford Raffles in 1808 saved what remains of it today. The Portuguese built St. Paul's Church – originally named "Our Lady of the Hill", and St. Francis Xavier was briefly buried here in 1553. Then the Dutch came and turned the chapel into a burial ground. You will also see the Malacca's Sultan's Palace (outside visit only), a replica of the original 15th Century Palace of Malacca's extinct Sultanate – it is now the Culture Museum. Your next stop will be the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple – the oldest Chinese Temple in the country. You will go on to Kampong Morten to see a Malay Living Museum, the Villa Sentosa where tea and local cakes will be served.

WALK TO DUTCH TRAIL

Melaka, once an old spice centre for Eastern and Western traders, has a colorful history involving its founder, the Malay Sultans, European powers and the formation of unique communities. These impressive historical eras have left their own unique heritage and influences for visitors to see and feel. The walking tour will help you to discover the great empires in Malacca, the Malay Sultanate, the Portuguese, the Dutch, and the British. The first venue will be the Dutch Square; the Stadthuys (outside visit) was built in the 1650s as the official residence for the Dutch governors and officers. It is a classic example of Dutch architecture, preserved in its original structure and form. Christ Church (outside visit), standing exactly where it has always been since 1753, is another landmark of the Dutch who defeated the Portuguese in 1641. Walking up St. Paul's Hill, you will see the ruins of the St. Paul's Church where St. Francis Xavier, a famous missionary, was briefly buried in 1553. You will visit the hallmark of Malacca, one of the most photographed sites, the A'Famosa (outside visit), built by the Portuguese as a fortress. Coming down the hill to Porta de Santiago, you will also see wooden replica of the Malacca Sultan's Palace, built with great detail and refinement. You will return to the pier by the local colorful trishaw (pedal bike): an exciting and unforgettable experience to don't loose!!

MALACCA AND SURROUNDINGS

This tour begins with a visit to a palm oil plantation. Currently, Malaysia exports more than 70% of the world's palm oil supply. Generally palm oil is widely used as a deep-fat frying and cooking oil for products like potato crisps or doughnuts. In addition technology has made palm oil versatile in that it is also used in the manufacture of emulsifiers and a host of non-edible products including soaps, detergents and other downstream oleo chemicals. Your next stop will be at a rubber tree plantation where you will be briefed on the process and end products of rubber. Malaysia produces almost 20% of the world's natural rubber. Rubber is elastic, flexible, airtight, watertight, long lasting and insulating, to mention just a few of its properties. There are thousand of products which take advantage of these useful properties. Some will be familiar to you, others less so because many rubber products do their work unseen. Most of the world's rubber is used in tires. You will then visit a Malaccan traditional house (outside visit), a splendid example of Malacca's 19th Century architectural and artistic style. Our final stop before we return to the pier will be at the Porta de Santiago, built by the Portuguese and the Portuguese-built St. Paul's Church - originally named "Our Lady of the Hill", where St. Francis Xavier was briefly buried in 1553. Then the Dutch came and turned the chapel into a burial ground. You will also see Malacca's Sultan's Palace (outside visit), a replica of the original 15th century palace of Malacca's extinct Sultanate - it is now the Culture Museum. Before returning to the pier you'll stop at the Straits Mosque, from where you can admire the fascinating view of Malacca's bay.

Please Note: The order of the itinerary may vary. Space is limited, so please reserve early. When visiting the traditional house shoes should be removed and it's recommended to wear socks. Appropriate dress code for the mosque is the following: for ladies long pants or long skirt and long sleeves; for men trousers and adequate t-shirt or shirt.
