The location offers a magnificent, all round view of the city, beaches, Guanabara Bay, and Sugarloaf Mountain. The famous statue which is made of stone and cement weighs 1,145 tons, and is the emblem of the city of Rio de Janeiro. After this stop, you will descend the Floresta da Tijuca mountain, whilst admiring the natural beauty and lush vegetation of urban Brazil's largest forest reserve. Afterwards, you continue in the direction of the Leblón, Ipanema and Copacabana neighbourhoods, arriving at Praia Vermelha and the Urca neighbourhood. Here, you take a cable car up to Sugarloaf Mountain. JEEP TOUR TO CORCOVADO AND TIJUCA FOREST

This exciting tour begins with a visit to the Christ the Redeemer Statue, located at the peak of the Corcovado Mountain. You will then cross Rua Paineiras to reach Alfonso Vizeu Square, located near the beautiful panoramic spot of Boa Vista. You will then venture directly to the heart of the lush Tijuca Forest, the largest urban forest in the world, and you will make a 15 minute stop near the Cascatinha Waterfall, which marks the boundary of the forest. The guides will enlighten you with the interesting story of Tijuca Forest and will talk about the importance of the Atlantic Forest for Brazil's environment, as well as the uniqueness of the fauna and flora that lives there. The tour will continue with a visit to the Mayrink Chapel, from where you will begin a roughly 30 minute walk along

an easy trail, during which you will have the opportunity to admire the forest plant life. Jeeps will be waiting for you at the end of the trail. On leaving the National Park, you will visit the Açude da Solidão Dam, the panoramic spot of Boa Vista and Vista Chinesa. Here you will enjoy a breathtaking view of Rio and will be able to take some beautiful pictures. You will continue the tour with a visit of the Emperor's Table, where the Brazilian imperial family liked to have picnics. You will then pass by the Cachoeira dos Macacos Waterfall, where you will be able to appreciate the beauty, before making the return journey to the ship.

Please note: Space is limited, so please book early. In case of bad weather conditions the panoramic view could be reduced. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended. This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems. According to a new local procedure, it's no possible to reach the Christ by jeep and the last part of the excursion will be by local bus. In case of bad weather conditions the tour could be cancelled. This excursion is not recommended for pregnant women.

PETRÓPOLIS, THE IMPERIAL CITY OF BRASIL

We will depart from pier to Petrópolis, also known as the Imperial City of Brazil. Petrópolis is a town in the state of Rio de Janeiro, about 65 km from Rio de Janeiro. Nestled among the forested hills of the Serra dos Órgãos, in the valley of the Quitandinha and Piabanha rivers, Petrópolis is a popular summer holiday spot. Besides the climate and surroundings, the main attraction is the former Summer Palace of the second Brazilian Emperor, which is now a museum, specializing in Imperial history and memorabilia. We will stop in front of the Quitandinha, an impressive building which once contained the largest casino in Latin America. It operated for only two years (gambling was banned in Brazil in 1946). Today, it is a convention center. Our next stop will be the Cathedral São Pedro de Alcântara in French Neogothic style, dates from 1939. The 70 meter (230 foot) building houses the Imperial Chapel, which contains the remains of Dom Pedro II, his wife Dona Teresa Cristina, his daughter Princess Isabel and her husband Conde D´Eu. After we will reach the Imperial Museum, summer residence of the imperial family, where you will see all the museum's treasures. On display are personal belongings of the former Emperor Dom Pedro II and his family, including paintings, rugs and the famous all gold imperial crown containing 639 diamonds and weighing 1,720 grammes, which was made for the coronation of the Emperor in 1841. You will also see the hall of carriages and the imperial locomotive. After lunch we will lead to Santos-Dumont Museum, residence of the scientist and inventor Santos-Dumont, the father of aviation. He himself designed the house, which is known as the "A Encantada". It was built in 1918 and was turned into a museum in 1946. Amongst its treasures, you will see furniture, decorative pieces, etc.

Please note: This tour does not operate on Mondays. Space is limited so please reserve early. Visitors must wear felt slippers when touring the Imperial Museum.

CORCOVADO AND COPACABANA

Leaving the port, you pass through the residential neighborhood of Laranjeiras, reaching the train station in Cosme Velho. Considered as the smallest railway in the world with 3824 meters length, it was inaugurated by Emperor Peter II, with steam traction, on October 9, 1884, which in 1912 began to have electric traction. After boarding the train for a 20 minute trip to the top of Corcovado Mountain which is one of the hills of the city of Rio de Janeiro, famous in Brazil and in the world for its statue of Christ the Redeemer. It lies in the Tijuca National Park. The Christ statue is 30 meters high on a pedestal of 8 meters, located at the top of the mountain 709 meters to sea level, it offers a privileged view of the city of Rio de Janeiro. The famous statue weighs 1,145 tons, made of soapstone and concrete is the greatest symbol of the city of Rio de Janeiro. In 2003 the works were completed with the

installation of elevators and escalators. In July 2007, the statue of Christ the Redeemer was elected in a vote of the "New 7 Wonders of the World." After that, descend the mountain train in the Tijuca Forest, where they will have opportunity to see the great beauty and vegetation of the largest forest reserve in an urban area in the world. After this visit, we will continue by bus for free time in Copacabana. Located in the south of the city is considered one of the most famous neighborhoods of Brazil, with a beach like a half-moon which is nicknamed "Princess of the Sea" because of its poetic aura, famous since the 1930, 1940 and 1950. On weekends, the strip of sand is also full of residents from different regions of Rio and domestic and foreign tourists who use the good transport infrastructure of the neighborhood to bask in the sun and waves. The boardwalk with its famous black and white waves, flanked by the bike path is a great option for runners and cyclists.

Note: In the event that the station is crowded, you may have a waiting time before boarding the train to Corcovado Mountain. In case of overloading of the train station, it is possible that the rise and fall of the Corcovado either by bus. In case of inclement weather the panoramic view can be reduced. The elevator and the escalators to get the Christ do not work in case of bad weather. Do not forget to bring a swimsuit, a towel and sunscreen! Beach chair and umbrella are NOT included in the Tour.

ECOTOUR AND TIJUÍPE WATERFALLS

Departing from the port of Ilheus towards the South Coast we will cross a beautiful highway that goes through the Atlantic forest and the beautiful South Coast beaches. We will arrive to CEPLAC, important center of Cocoa researches and preservation of species of the fauna of the Atlantic Forest. We will visit the "Sloth Project" (animal that is in threat of extinction, whose natural habitat is the Brazilian Atlantic forest). We will make a short stop to visit a special prototype of cocoa farming, continuing with a visit to a Chocolate factory. We continue the tour up to Ilheus downtown for a short photo before driving towards the northern beaches along the Ilhéus-Itacaré road (the first environmentally friendly road in Brazil). The drive will take you through an extraordinary landscape, featuring mango plantations, rocks, thick forests and nature reserves. The protection of the natural environment has even extended to the installation of nets across the treetops in some places, to enable small animals such as monkeys, squirrels and various types of insects to cross the road in complete safety. En route you will stop at Serra Grande to see Ilhéus' splendid beaches, where you can take photographs. The tour continues to Tijupe Waterfall, where you can swim in the falls, stroll along the narrow paths and take photographs of the region's most beautiful waterfall. This spot has a restaurant and changing facilities.

Note: The trip is not recommended to guests with locomotion difficulties. Space is limited, so please reserve early. Don't forget a swimsuit, towel and sunscreen. Participants must be at least 6 years of age. This tour does not feature a guide.

ITACAREZINHO BEACH

You will depart from the port of Ilhéus towards the northern beaches along the Ilhéus-Itacaré road (the first environmentally friendly road in Brazil). EXPERIENCE DAY - ECO ADVENTURE TOUR

Leaving the port, we will start a panoramic tour around the village of Ilhéus, land of the cocoa and birthplace of the famous Brazilian writer Jorge Amado. The bus will go along the seaside on the street "Avenida Soares Lopes" to the main square of the Cathedral, where we can find the Cafe Vesuvius and the statue of Jorge Amado. The panoramic tour continues up to the hill, where it is situated the Convent of the Pity (Convento da Piedade). There, we will have a short stop in a viewpoint, from where we can admire a beautiful sight of the city and its islands. Later on, there will be a descent by bus to reach a square, where there is a Statue of Christ the Redeemer for a photo stop. The next part of the visit starts at the Marina of Sapitinga where begins our picturesque adventure on board of a Brazilian typical boat called "Saveiro". We will sail on the waters of the river "Rio Santana", having the opportunity to admire the mangroves and the exuberant vegetation of this region. After a while, the boat reaches the pier of the property "Fazenda

Recreio", where the owner himself is waiting to take us for a walking tour through a track in the middle of the Atlantic forest, exuberant autochthonous vegetation with its innumerable kinds of trees and plants (Mata Atlântica). At the end of the walking tour, we will reach a part of the property, where there is a plantation of Cocoa, caoutchouc (seringueiras) and trees of tropical fruits such as jaca, sapoti, siriguela, cajá, graviola, bananas among many others. We will have the opportunity to experience, along with the local hosts, the process of cultivation of the cocoa, from seeding to harvest, up to the final product, ready to be exported. The lunch, prepared and served by the owner of this enchanting place, is based on vegetables of the local garden, grilled meat, chicken and sausages. Last, but not least, a delicious homemade dessert will close this gastronomic experience. After the meal, ecologically correct, we will have some free time to relax and enjoy the beautiful surroundings and landscapes of the place as well as this picturesque and typical Brazilian cottage.

ILHEUS & JORGE AMADO

You will leave the Port of Ilhéus, Bahia's third tourist destination and inspiration for the novels of the renowned Bahian writer Jorge Amado. You will stop for photos at Tonico Bastos' house. Tonico Bastos was a notary public and a bohemian figure well known in the city for his romantic conquests, who became the protagonist of the book "Gabriela Cravo e Canela". You will visit the former Bataclã cabaret (which is also the setting of the book "Gabriela Cravo e Canela"), a favourite of the landed cocoa growers (the so-called cocoa barons) at the beginning of the last century, where there was a casino and a show hall for the courtesans. Today, this beautiful house has been renovated, with rooms in the same style as at the beginning of the last century, as well as a restaurant, a shop and a stage for themed photos. You will take a walking tour down Rua Arthur Lavigne, also known as Rua dos coronéis (the Barons' Street), stopping for photos at the Mansion of Misael Tavares, an imposing neoclassical-style building that was the residence of this farmer and entrepreneur, who was a well-known figure throughout the city. You will visit the Fundação Cultural Casa de Jorge Amado, the writer's residence during his infancy and part of his adolescence. Today it is home to the Fundação Cultural Casa de Jorge Amado, and tells visitors more about his life. You will then go on to Vesúvio, the oldest and most popular bar and restaurant in the city since the time of the "barons". There, you will taste the delightful typical delicacies (kibbeh and cocoa juice). Vesúvio is a meeting point in the centre of Ilhéus, and is also mentioned in Jorge Amado's books. You will continue on to the grand finale of this tour, visiting the "Fazenda", an area with beautiful landscapes, rivers, forests, mountains and the "Baron's house" with authentic furniture from the last century, as you relive the history of the landed cocoa growers and experience the culinary delicacies of the region with lunch served in the house itself.

Please note: Space is limited, so please reserve early. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended.

Casablanca **FES**

If we had to visit only one city of Morocco, our choice would fall on Fez for its architectural wealth, the fascinating medina, the magnificent monuments, as well as for its history that make Fez the cultural capital of the country. Religious, intellectual and artistic metropolis of Morocco, crib of a millennial monarchy, Fez was for a long time the political capital of the empire. After a journey by bus, crossing a pleasant country, we will reach Fèz. We will enter the medieval city through the monumental door Bab Bou Jeloud, decorated with maioliche enameled resplendent to the sun, we will find ourselves absorbed in a world where life stirs to rhythms by now unknown: the artisans work with skill using original tools, the women cook the bread in the public oven, the weavers they work on looms following gestures consolidated by a secular tradition, the donkeys, the only means of transport permitted inside the medina, commodities of every type are bought and sold. We will visit the Medersa Bouanania, wanted by the sultan Abou Inan, whose courtyard is marvelously realized in marble and onyx. A lunch of typical Moroccan dishes will be served inside the Mnebhi building, one of the more refined buildings of the Medina, from whose terrace we can admire the surrounding panorama. We will continue the visit with a walk through a labyrinth of alleys of the Medina, place of thousand discoveries and feelings, where every zone entertains a different guild of artisans: the souk Attarine, entirely devoted to the spices, the souk Nejarine, devoted to the carpenters, Place Seffarine, populated with blacksmiths shops, the dyers' souk where skeins of silk are hung to dry in the sun. We will explore together with our guide the most fascinating souk of Fèz, that of the conciatoris, announced by the strong and sharp odor of the hides. From a panoramic terrace we will see the extraordinary job and tradition of dying of the skins in the great tubs. We will pass in front of the Mausoleum of Moulay Idriss, founder of the millennial city of Fez, a place revered by the Moslems. Through the richly decorated principal wooden door, we can glimpse the room of prayer, with his/her innumerable chandeliers and an amazing collection of clocks, among which two splendid clocks given by Luigi XIV, the King Alone. We will pass close to the Mosque Kairouyine, founded in the destination' of the IX century, also centre of a famous university' defined as the most ancient in the world. The building is closed to the non Moslems, but from it's numerous doors we can glimpse some of the precious treasures. We will leave the medieval city passing the fortitude Saadita of Borj Nord, here we have a photo opportunity to capture the whole and mysterious Medina. Before leaving again to return to Casablanca, we will cross the Jewish district of Mellah, stopping in front of the

Royal Building.

Please note: The duration of the excursion will be approx. 13 hours of which 8 hours approx. will be on the coach. There will be lots of walking therefore we suggest comfortable shoes. The limited areas inside Souk can have short queues of tourists especially on the leather-tanning terrace. Space is limited, so please book early. This tour will introduce you to Casablanca and Rabat, both fine examples of modern urban development which nevertheless retain all the characteristic atmosphere of Moroccan cities. The itinerary begins with a drive along the Boulevard de la Résistance towards the Royal Palace (external visit) and the Palace of Justice with a stop at the market. A must see along the way is the new and highly acclaimed Hassan II Mosque, a magnificent and astonishing monument. Upon leaving Casablanca, the tour moves on to Rabat. The tour of Rabat includes an external view of the Royal Palace, a splendid imitation of the highest examples of Islamic architecture; Mechouar, the mausoleum of Mohammed V; and the Hassan Tower. The tour stops for lunch at a restaurant, before continuing through Medina and the Kasbah of the Oudayas. The tour also includes a brief stop at a bazaar or at a typical Berber pharmacy.

Please note: Appropriate clothing is recommended to enter places of worship access to. Shoulders and knees must be covered while visiting the mosque. Shoes must be removed. In case of religious celebrations or holidays, the tour will visit but not enter the Hassan II Mosque. In the event of religious celebrations or national holyday the visit of the mausoleum Mohammed V will be an external view only. Space is limited, so please book early. The order of the itinerary may vary

MARRAKECH

Marrakech, chief town of the homonym province and the city that, for a long time has embodied the "Moroccan dream" of the most curious and romantic travelers. Situated at the feet of the tall Atlas mountains, in a fertile region, and the most famous imperial city of Morocco. Arriving from Casablanca, we will leave the bus near the medieval bastions of Marrakech to proceed in on foot into the ancient city: the Medina. Our guide will lead us on foot to the Mosque of the Koutoubia (or of the booksellers), erected in the XII century and so named because in years gone by the shops of book merchants surrounded it's walls. From it's imposing and stupendous minaret, masterpiece of the Hispanic-Moorish art, the muezzin calls the inhabitants of the city every day to prayer. Lunch gives us an opportunity to relax and to taste some food typical of the local kitchen. We will then continue our walk exploring the Bahia building, founded toward 1880 by the visir Ba Ahmed, Prime Minister of the sultan of Marrakech. We will admire the sumptuous building, a true masterpiece of Moroccan art, of such architectural charm it has featured in and set the ambience of films such as: Ali Baba and the 40 thieves, The lion of the desert and Casablanca. We will enter one of the Medina, with our guide and meander some of it's thousands of alleyways which swarm with frantic activity we will discover the "riad", the ancient Moroccan main residences from the luxuriant courtyards, that, with their original architectures and the refined decoration, make Marrakech a city' of incomparable charm. We will be surprised and fascinated by the colored walls, that have witness the life of the Medina for many years. We will pass near a Fondouk, an ancient hotel used by merchants, before continuing to the Medersa Ibn Youssef, one of the great est Koranic schools of Morocco, founded in 1565 and able to entertain up to 400 students and teachers. Decorated in plaster, mosaic and inlays of cedar wood, the building still maintains intact its great structure which is similar to a monastery. Transiting through the historic Talaa plaza, we will admire from the outside the mosque Ibn Youssef. From here we will walk in the colourful and perfumed world of the souks of Marrakech. In the lanes covered with reeds and lanterns a wealth of local handicraft are shown. From the blacksmiths' souk to the souk of the babouches and the souk Semmarine where we will be able' to admire the coloured universe of the braid. We will see an unimaginable selection of spices, fruit's, typical sweets and olives. We will come, finally, to the most famous plaza in Morocco, the Jemaa plaza el Fna, here we will find a colourful crowd of dancers, cantastorie, snake charmers and monkey trainers. The pulsating heart of the whole city', the site was proclaimed a "Masterpiece of the oral and immaterial patrimony of the humanity' by UNESCO in 2001". Marrakesh will leave you with a lasting image of Morocco as a fascinating and interesting country.

Please note: the excursion will take approximately 13 hours, 7/8 of which make up the coach trip. There will be lots of walking therefore we suggest comfortable shoes. The order of the itinerary may vary. The excursion is not recommended for people with walking difficulties. There will be a stop for some shopping in a typical Berber pharmacy before getting back on the bus for Casablanca.

TOUR OF CASABLANCA, HASSAN II MOSQUE

Casablanca, founded in 1515 by the Portuguese, is now an expanding and dynamic metropolis, with wide avenues lined by modern buildings of typical European style. Our tour starts along the Boulevard de la Résistance towards the Royal Palace (outside only) and the Law Courts. In this part of the city we will be able to view the typical handicraft shops and the picturesque olive market. The excursion then proceeds to the Habous Quarter, the Church of Notre Dame de Lourdes and the beautiful Mohammed V Square. You'll then visit the mosque of Hassan II, second in its size only to the Mecca. To complete the tour, you'll enjoy a drive along the panoramic coastal road (the Corniche). On this drive you will cross the residential quarter of Anfa and Ain Diab, a tourist area with splendid swimming pools hidden among the rocks, and lots of restaurants, bars and nightclubs. A typical shopping stop will end our excursion.

Please note: Appropriate clothing is recommended for access to the holy places. Shoulders and knees must be covered while visiting the mosque. In case of religious celebrations or holidays, the tour will visit but not enter the Hassan II Mosque.

The last part of your tour will lead you to know the area of the city that historically linked it to the sea: Porta Soprana, Columbus House, Via San Lorenzo, Palazzo Ducale and the Old Port. At the end you will have some free time under the old arcades of Sotto Ripa.

You'll then head towards the little cathedral that houses the ashes of Prince Rainier and the much-loved Princess Grace, tragically killed in a car accident, the circumstances of which remain shrouded in mystery to this day. In the late morning you'll travel by bus to Monte Carlo, the most famous area in the principality and known for its casino, luxury hotels, glamour and the roads on which the famous Formula 1 Grand Prix is raced every year. Here you'll have time to take a relaxing walk or do a bit of shopping in some of the most exclusive designer boutiques in the world.

Please note: Journey time to and from Monaco is approximately 2 hours each way. In the case that religious celebrations are taking place, the cathedral will only be visited externally. To participate in this excursion an official ID is required. This excursion is reserved for guests who do not disembark in Savona.

After making a panoramic tour of Savona by bus, we will meet in the centre and continue our journey by foot, visiting the Pinacoteca Civica. Here you will be able to see sculptures, paintings and ceramics from the 16th - 20th century. For guests who do not wish to visit the Pinacoteca, you will be able to enjoy free time in the city before returning onboard.
